Artwork must be 100% hand-drawn on a 8½" X 11" white piece of paper. Any medium may be used but please refrain from using yellow/white/light colours (as top posters are scanned and blown up for judging at the provincial level in order to select the provincial grand prize winner).

- 3. Posters will be judged based on the following criteria:
- Knowledge and information presented within the poster is accurate (i.e. shows the student's understanding of the topic).
- The artwork demonstrates an appreciation of water & wildlife.
- General artistic ability and creativity.
